SAME DEUTZ-FAHR also chose Innov-agri as the showcase for the new **Deutz-Fahr C7000 combine harvester** range. Last year, the 2013 edition of Innov-agri hosted in Toulouse set the stage for the launch of the C9000. This year, it was the turn of the new series with which the Treviglio-based brand extends its choice of combine harvesters even further.

This new generation of machines features a style coherent with the tractors of the brand and also penned by Giugiaro Design, with an elegant but functional design to ensure easy access for maintenance. The range has been extended yet again to respond even more effectively to the need for greater productivity and versatility, with models optimised specifically for lower fuel consumption and superior reliability and durability. The machine is offered in a choice of four models (the C7205 and C7205 TS with 5 straw walkers and the C7206 and C7206 TS with 6 straw walkers) and two hillside models (C7205 TSB and C7206 TSB). DEUTZ engines producing 246 kW (334 hp) for the C7206 and C7206TS, 211 kW (287 hp) for the C7205TS and 184 kW (287 hp) for the C7205 deliver outstanding performance combined with among the lowest consumption figures in its class, with SCR exhaust after-treatment technology with AdBlue and the advanced, exclusive construction of the machine itself.
